

はしがき

英語俳句ー相互理解への早道

第14回山寺芭蕉記念館英語俳句大会 実行委員長 大場 登

(公財)山形市文化振興事業団主催事業で「山寺から世界へ」を目指して14年前に始まった本大 会は、今年も山形市関係機関や多くの方々からご理解・ご協力を得、成功裏に終えることができま した。感謝申し上げます。その成果としてここに入選句集をお届けすることができ、うれしく思い ます。

今回は、募集期間が7月1日~8月19日と12日間昨年よりも短かったにもかかわらず、海外 27カ国を含む、3部門合計して参加者2,049名から2,759句の応募がありました。本『入 選作品集』に掲載した入選者は326名、374句。数字の示す通り、かなり厳しい選考結果とな りました。応募状況等の統計の詳細については本誌4ページをご参照ください。

審査には、飯島武久山形大名誉教授が審査員長、大場登同大会実行委員会委員長、万里小路譲山 形県詩人協会副会長、リサ ソマーズ(翻訳家・山形大学非常勤講師)、並びに相馬周一郎山形市 文化振興事業団理事長の5名に当たっていただきました。優れた作品が多い中、特に目立ったのは、 各部最優秀1句、優秀2句の入賞作品。いずれも俳句の神髄である簡潔性、それでいて含意に富む ものばかりでした。

ご案内の通り、英語俳句の大まかな定義は、「2~3行からなる短い英詩(押韻しなくてもよい)、 5・7・5の音節や季語は必ずしも守らなくてもよい」となっております。私の観察では、英語俳句 の詠みの対象は、やはり日本の俳句同様、花鳥風月が多いのですが、人間の心の動きや心理や哲学 的な内容などが含まれたより幅広い題材になっているようです。

したがって、英語俳句を鑑賞したり作句したりすることにより、異国に住み、違った考えを持つ 人達が、今や世界共通となった世界最短の文学形態である俳句に取り組むことによって、「光り輝 く最短の語群による世界創世の可能性」を追求でき、世代間や国際的相互理解の早道であると信じ ております。

終わりに、今後も、国内外の老若男女、特により多くの若い人たちが、英語俳句に取り組み、英 語俳句により友好の場が広がっていくこと。そのために、本大会の募集区分を敢えて「日本人大人 ・外国人大人」、「高校生」、「中学生」に分けた本大会にご注目をいただき、次回大会にも世界各地 より多くの方々からご応募いただけますよう願っております。

Foreword

Pursuing Mutual Understanding through the English Haiku

The Yamadera Basho Memorial Museum English Haiku Contest began 14 years ago with the aim of spreading the English haiku from Yamadera to the rest of the world. As always, we would like to express our gratitude to the Yamagata City Culture Foundation, the city of Yamagata, and the many individuals who support this endeavor, and we are pleased to present the results of this year's contest in this collection of selected haiku submissions.

This year, we accepted submissions to our contest from July 1 to August 19. While this was almost two weeks shorter than last year's submission period, we still received a total of 2759 haiku submissions from 2049 applicants in Japan and 27 countries around the world, and of these, 374 submissions from 326 applicants passed the rigorous initial screening. For more detailed data related to this year's submissions, please refer to p. 4 of this booklet.

The second screening to select the Grand Prize and two Distinguished Work recipients in each category was carried out by a five-member judging panel consisting of Takehisa Iijima (Professor Emeritus of Yamagata University), Joe Maricoji (Vice-President of the Yamagata Prefecture Poetry Association), Lisa Somers (translator and part-time instructor at Yamagata University), Shuichiro Soma (Yamagata City Culture Foundation Chairman), and myself. From the excellent group of works which passed the first screening, we chose haiku poems which particularly impressed us as being rich in poetic nuance and connotations, while still retaining the succinct simplicity which distinguishes the haiku form of poetry.

At its most basic, the haiku poem is defined as a brief two or three-line non-rhyming poem which often follows a 5-7-5 syllable structure and includes *kigo* (seasonal words), but is not obligated to do so. From my own observations, I have noticed that while many English haiku poems focus on the same traditional themes of natural beauty which are commonly found in Japanese haiku, they also delve widely into emotional, psychological and philosophical realms.

As a result, through the appreciation and composition of the English haiku – the world's shortest form of poetry which is now enjoyed internationally – people of different cultures and beliefs can pursue the creation of vivid worlds of thought and contemplation in the space of a few short lines, something which I believe encourages mutual understanding between different generations and the many diverse countries and regions which exist across the globe.

I hope that people of all ages, nationalities and backgrounds, particularly those of the younger generation, will continue to explore the possibilities of the English haiku poem, discovering friendships and common interests through this pursuit. The four divisions of our haiku contest welcome the participation of Japanese adults, overseas participants, high school students and junior high school students, and we look forward to receiving many submissions from applicants around the world next year as well.
